



BECOME A STUDENT Ambassador

What is a Student Ambassador?

Student Ambassadors are currently enrolled as students who represent WSU Tri-Cities and the Office of Student Affairs. Student Ambassadors correspond with prospective students and parents, alumni, and community members. Student Ambassadors work together to build on our University's outstanding reputation and to bring future Cougars to the Tri-Cities campus.

What do Student Ambassadors do?

Student Ambassadors are responsible for easing prospective students' transitions into WSU Tri-Cities. Student Ambassadors also participate in recruitment events, new student orientation, give campus tours to prospective students, give admissions presentations, and work in the Admissions Office.

What are the benefits of being a Student Ambassador?

Student Ambassadors earn a partial tuition waiver (based upon number of credits enrolled) and learn a variety of skills that are useful for any major and gain valuable work experience. Student Ambassadors will develop as leaders and learn to give group presentation while improving their public speaking skills. Student Ambassadors also have the opportunity to work one on one with university staff and other community members.

What are the time and availability commitments of a Student Ambassador?

Student Ambassadors are appointed each Spring Semester and serve through the Fall Semester. The appointments run from January to December each year. Student Ambassadors must be available to work 150 hours each semester and be available over the summer; this time includes some evening and weekend hours. Student Ambassadors must also be able to travel both regionally and locally. Students may also re-apply for another term as a Student Ambassador.

What are the qualifications to become a Student Ambassador?

Student Ambassadors must be:

- *Currently enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours at WSU Tri-Cities with a 2.5 GPA or higher*
- *Demonstrated leadership and communication (presentation and public speaking) skills*
- *Have a valid, unrestricted Washington State driver's license*
- *Shall not be on disciplinary action as defined by the Washington State University Standards of Conduct for Students 2011-2012*
- *Not enrolled in more than 15 credits*
- *Student Ambassadors must also be able to take the UColl 400 (one credit) class in Spring 2012.*

Are you ready to become a Student Ambassador?

In order to apply to become a Student Ambassador please:

- Complete an application
- Submit a current résumé
- Please submit a 300 word essay that addresses the following questions:
 - ▶ Why is a college education important to you?
 - ▶ Why are you interested in becoming a student ambassador?
 - ▶ How have you demonstrated the characteristics necessary to be successful in college?

Applications are due no later than 5 p.m. on December 2 to Bradley Liebrecht in West 269B (or in West 201 in his mailbox). Qualified candidates will be contacted and interviewed for a position as a Student Ambassador. Interviews will take place the week of December 5th.
