This position involves development of MS instrumentation and methods for application in systems biology research. The successful candidate will be expected to contribute to ideas and methods for the expansion of existing research. This position will also expect assistance with preparation on reports, papers, posters, presentations, etc. Responsibilities may include biological sample preparation, preliminary application development for new technology, and significant downstream data analysis. The successful candidate must be highly motivated and interested in expanding his/her background while working in a highly interdisciplinary team-based environment. Maintenance of laboratory equipment, organization, working conditions, and an accurate laboratory notebook are expected in addition to implementation of Environmental Safety and Health (ES&H) Operations and security requirements, and MS&D policies. This is a full-time limited term employment position. The duration of this appointment is up to two months depending on project funding and individual performance.
