If you are interested in a graduate degree in the Department of Teaching and Learning at Washington State University, you must apply to both the Department and Graduate School. The Graduate School application is available on the web at: <http://www.gradsch.wsu.edu/>

For the Department of Teaching and Learning, this form requests information in addition to that required by the Graduate School. The faculty uses this information in the admission and advising process. The PRIORITY deadline for submitting a complete application is January 10 for summer admission. Please submit this form to the campus through which you plan to enroll.

A complete department application includes a letter of intent, Graduate School application, Supplemental Information Form, transcripts, current resume or vitae and three letters of recommendation (submitted electronically to the WSU Graduate School). The letter of intent must include: (1) the reason for pursuing a graduate degree, (2) a description of teaching or other life experience that relates to graduate study, (3) a commitment to scholarship or professional development, (4) a specific research or inquiry interest, (5) the unique perspective you would bring to the graduate program, and, if applying for an assistantship, (6) why you would be an effective teacher at the college level. The three letters of recommendation must address your (1) interpersonal skills, (2) scholarship, (3) experience with children or youth, and (4) facility with written, oral, and interpersonal communication. In addition, if applying for a teaching assistantship, one of the letters must also address your effectiveness as a teacher.

In addition to the above application requirements, you must also submit an academic writing sample. This writing sample must be a formal, academic writing sample such as a thesis or paper.
