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## General Information

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### Blueberries

**Mummyberry disease** (*Monilinia vaccinicorymbosi*): Apply 6 fl. oz. of Orbit per acre (= 77 g ai of propiconazole per A, 0.165 lbs ai/A) at leaf bud break. If necessary, repeat at a minimum of 7 day intervals up to full bloom and early petal fall.

Treatments may be made with either ground or aerial equipment. The product is to be applied at a rate of 6 fl. oz. product (0.165 lbs. a.i.) per acre per application. A maximum number of 3 applications at this rate (a total of 18 fl. oz. product) may be applied per acre per season.

Use a minimum of 20-50 gallons of water per acre by ground application, or a minimum of 5-10 gallons of water per acre by air.

- **DO NOT** apply within 30 days of harvest.
- **DO NOT** apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

For ground applications apply only when there is sustained wind away from fish-bearing waters, or leave a 10 foot untreated buffer between treatment area and fish-bearing waters to protect endangered aquatic species, or use low-pressure nozzles according to manufacturer's specifications that produce only coarse or very coarse droplets. For aerial applications apply only when there is sustained wind away from fish-bearing waters, or leave a 75 foot untreated buffer between treatment area and fish-bearing waters to protect endangered aquatic species.

The restricted entry interval (REI) is 24-hours.

Syngenta does not recommend mixing this product with any other crop protection product.

Any adverse effects resulting from the use of Orbit under this emergency exemption must be immediately reported to the Washington State Department of Agriculture.
