FOR DISTRIBUTION AND USE ONLY ON TIMOTHY, TIMOTHY/ALFALFA AND TIMOTHY/CLOVER MIXTURES PRODUCED FOR HAY AND TIMOTHY PRODUCED FOR SEED IN THE COUNTY OF KITTITAS, STATE OF WASHINGTON

It is a violation of State and Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application. All applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions on the registered product label for Prozap Zinc Phosphide Oat Bait (EPA Reg. No. 61282-14) and Prozap Zinc Phosphide Pellets (EPA Reg. No. 2393-521) are to be followed. Any adverse effects resulting from the use of Prozap Zinc Phosphide Oat Bait or Prozap Zinc Phosphide Pellets under this emergency exemption must be immediately report to the Washington State Department of Agriculture.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For control of voles (*microtus*) complex, use a maximum of 2 ground broadcast applications, one in the fall after the last cutting and one in the spring when timothy and timothy-legume mixtures are still dormant, at the rate of 5 to 10 pounds of either Prozap® Zinc Phosphide Oat Bait or Prozap® Zinc Phosphide Pellets per acre.

Other Applicable Restrictions:

- Total combined quantity applied cannot exceed 520,000 lbs of product or 10,400 lbs. active ingredient zinc phosphide (5,200 lbs. ai in the fall and 5,200 lbs ai in the spring) to a maximum of 26,000 acres of timothy and timothy/alfalfa and timothy/clover mixtures produced for hay and timothy produced for seed using either Prozap® Zinc Phosphide Oat Bait or Prozap® Zinc Phosphide Pellets.
- Do not apply zinc phosphide under this exemption to actively growing timothy or timothy/alfalfa or clover mixtures.
- Do not apply zinc phosphide within a 100-foot radius of potable wells.
- Do not apply zinc phosphide within 40 feet of any watercourse, including but not limited to ditches, irrigation canals, drainage areas, or other areas where surface water is present.
- Do not apply zinc phosphide by air.
- Do not inject or introduce zinc phosphide into any type of irrigation system (e.g. chemigation).
- Do not graze animals on treated area for sixty days after an application.
- A visual assessment of the field must be performed to estimate the population of voles before treating with zinc phosphide. A survey of the number of runs/holes, feeding activity, and/or amount of damage can be used to estimate population densities.
- Do not apply more than a combined total of 0.2 pounds zinc phosphide active ingredient per application per acre using either Prozap® Zinc Phosphide Oat Bait or Prozap® Zinc Phosphide Pellets.
